

Marshall Wrestling Club Scholarship Award

Marshall Wrestling Club, Inc. will award one (1) \$1,0000 (one thousand dollar) scholarship to a qualified senior member of the Marshall High School wrestling team graduating going on to a high level of education to help defray the costs of college tuition. **NEW for 2023:** Up to \$500 in scholarship funds may be awarded to applicants who do not receive the primary scholarship.

To be considered, each applicant must be currently participating in wrestling at Marshall High School, be accepted at an accredited 2 or 4 year university, college, or trade school, and submit the following by April 15:

- 1. A completed application form** (available at www.marshallwrestlingclub.org)
- 2. Three letters of recommendation** that attest to the applicant's character, academic and community accomplishment, and potential future
- 3. An essay** (500-1000 words) covering:
 1. What participating in wrestling has done to improve his/her life.
 2. Why the applicant is attending higher education and why the applicant chose the college, university, or trade school he/she will be attending.
 3. What the applicant foresees doing as a career.

4. Copy of transcripts

The winner of the scholarship will be chosen by the Marshall Wrestling Club Scholarship Committee which has been appointed by the officers of the club. Criteria for award will include the strength of the recommendation letters and essay, grade point average, team leadership skills, community involvement, participation in youth club programs, and quality of the applicant as a role model both on and off the mat (as a student-athlete and citizen).

The recipient of the scholarship will be announced at the Marshall Senior Awards Banquet. Award is dependent upon proving registration at an accredited 2 or 4 year college, university, or trade school. The funding for award will be made directly to the college, university or trade school, not to the recipient.

All interested candidates should submit completed application form, three letters of recommendation, and essay to:
